The Nevada Highway Patrol, Permit Section is happy to announce the new **Amber Light web-based application/permit**, will be up and running on **May 1, 2009**.

We will no longer be offering Flashing Amber Light Permits in Regions, customers must use web-site.

Please direct all Flashing Amber Light customers to the user-friendly web based on-line application **http://nhp.nv.gov**.

DIRECTION FOR NEW WEB-SITE

Flashing Amber Light customers will access the web based on-line application by going to, **http://nhp.nv.gov**, click in left hand box, Flashing Amber Light application. Then they will fill in their information and submit. After the application is complete, they must print **2 copies** of the application receipt and mail 1 copy with their payment to address on application receipt and other to keep for file.

After 15 days from days from the date they mail their application, they must go back into the web-site **http://nhp.nv.gov**, they will need to **type in their access code and transaction number**, which will be on their application receipt to verify their application acceptance and then print their permit.

Phase I is now complete. We are entering into Phase II, which will allow customers to pay with e-check, M/C or Visa. We will notify you when Phase II is operational.
